**Year 2000
State Championships**

This year marked the occasion of the 28th Annual Michigan Masters Swimming State Championships. About 220 swimmers from 19 teams turned up at the new Holland Community Aquatic Center facility during the weekend of April 14-16, to participate in this traditional event.

The South Oakland Seals won their 12th straight Large Team Championship. It was the teams 14th overall title in their 26 year history. Battle Creek YMCA (BCYM) won the Small Team Combined Championship for the 2nd time since 1994 and also added the Men's Small Team Championship which was the fifth non-combined title in a row over the last 5 years. Ford Athletic Swim & Triathlon Club (FAST) won the Women's Small Team Championship for the second year in a row. 12 State Records were set during the course of the meet. 16 swimmers won a maximum of 7 individual events (11 Women and 5 Men). Results and High Point Awards for both Team and Individual are included in this Newsletter. The host team Dutch Masters gave

Michigan Masters has two new officers that I would like to congratulate. Barb Bos is our new Sanctions Chair replacing Andrea Funk who did an excellent job with the sanction process this past year. Jim Coleman is our new Registrar replacing Bob Isbister and thank you Bob for stepping in when the LMSC really needed you. Bob will continue his duties as Marketing Chair. Also the Michigan Masters Review Committee has a new member, Marilyn Early, to go along with the 5 previous re-appointed members. I would like to remind everyone that there will be a General Membership Meeting on July 23, 2000 after the conclusion of the Dearborn Long Course Meet. Remember there is a free lunch picnic for all swimmers so I hope to see lots of people there!

I would like to congratulate the 16 Michigan Masters swimmers that were named to the 1999 USMS All American team. There were 9 Pool and 7 Long Distance All Americans. Michigan Masters also had 5 USMS All Stars (2 Pool and 3 Long Distance). To be named an All Star a swimmer must win more Swimming or Long Distance events than anybody else in the age group over the course of the year. Also a congratulations to the 15 people who were named 1999 Relay Team All Americans.

The 2000 USMS Short Course Nationals were just completed and I want to thank the 45 swimmers that swam in the meet. Michigan Masters Men's team took a second place team banner and the Women and Combined Teams took 4th place. Once again, Lois Nochman stole the spotlight winning all 6 of her events and setting 5 Nationals Records, just missing a 6th in her last event the 100 IM which she had set at the Rockford meet. Edith Glusac was close behind with 5 firsts and 1 second. This was Edith's best Nationals ever. Charles Moss, Bob Heritier, and Michael Green also were Individual National Champions. The 65+ age group Men's Free Relay of Robert Weddell, Bob Heritier, Charles Moss, and John Ries were Relay National Champions. This was the second time in a row for Charles, Bob and John because they won this same event at last summers nationals. Again, congratulations to all.

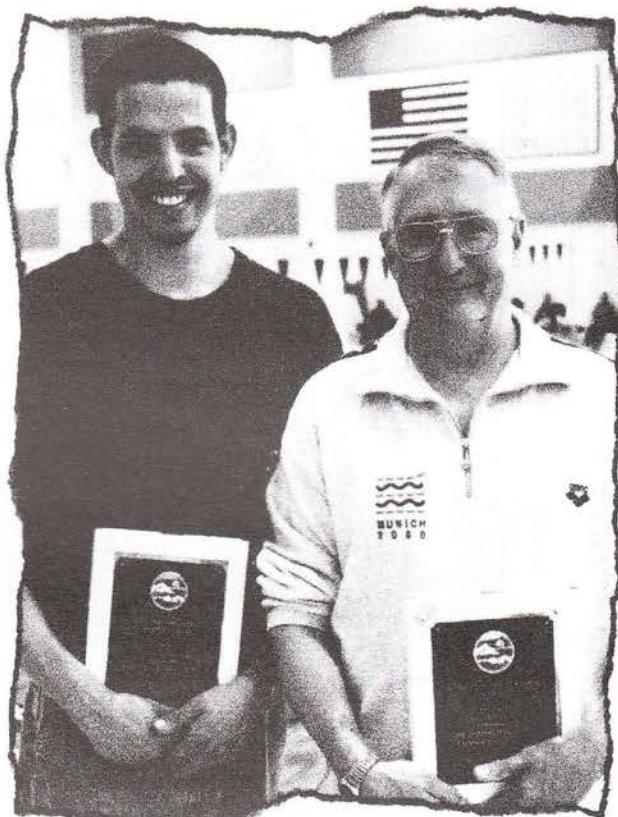

2000 Michigan Masters Award Winners

Every year Michigan Masters Swimming gives two special awards presented at the State Championship Meet. Since 1978, the Lawrence Award is given annually to those who have achieved outstanding performances in masters swimming representing Michigan Masters. This year's Lawrence Award recipient was Joe Tristan.

Joe started swimming competitively in Masters Swimming in 1997 after finishing a collegiate career at Eastern Michigan University. Joe is the youngest swimmer ever to achieve this award. Joe has been All American 3 straight years (1997-1999), has set 5 USMS National Records, and has been in the USMS Top Ten 29 times since 1997 resulting of which 26 of the 29 swims have been in the Top 3 places. Joe has 17 # 1 swims, 6 # 2 swims, and 3 # 3 swims in the USMS Top Ten since 1997. He won 2 National Championship meet titles at the 1999 Short Course Nationals in Santa Clara and was named to the Michigan Masters All Century Team. This year he was a USMS All Star for the 19-24 age group for the most #1 swims in his age group with 10.

Joe has currently made Olympic Trial Cuts for both the 100 and 200 Free. Joe is the Assistant Swim Coach for the Eastern Michigan University Men's swim team and maintains both the EMU Men's and Women's swim team Web Sites. He is currently working on a Masters degree in Web Site Technology. Congratulations Joe and good luck in the future both in and out of the pool.

The Chetrick Award has been awarded since 1977 and is given annually to those who have given outstanding service and/or best exemplify the spirit and commitment to Michigan Masters Swimming. This year's Chetrick award recipient was Don Kroeger. Don started swimming competitively in Masters Swimming in the Fall of 1989 and soon became Coach and Team Rep of the OHMI Masters Swim Team. OHMI was Small Team Combined and Women's Small Team State Champions in 1996 and 1998. Don served as Vice Chairman and Chairman from 1995 to 1999. He was also a member of the USMS National Fitness Committee from 1996 to 1999. He was Meet Director for the 1998 Michigan

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Masters State Championships at EMU. He has also been a Meet Director of the Monroe YMCA local swim meet since 1994.

Don was the Michigan Masters Team Rep at the 1994 and 1995 Short Course Nationals. He also assisted in helping with the 1996 Long Course National Relay which had 220 swimmers participate. This past year Don put together the Michigan Masters 3000 and 6000 postal swims relays which resulted in a Long Distance Postal National Championship. Don's swimming accomplishments include being named a Long Distance All American and a Long Distance All Star 3 times (1995, 1996-1998) and being a Relay Team All American 3 times (1996, 1998-1999). In 1994, Don was the USMS Long Course National Champion in the 800 Free at the Nationals in Buffalo. In 1999, Don was the Canadian National Champion (SCM) in the 200, 800, and 1500 Free. To date Don has won 4 Individual YMCA National Championships. Congratulations, Don.

Lynne Weir Awards

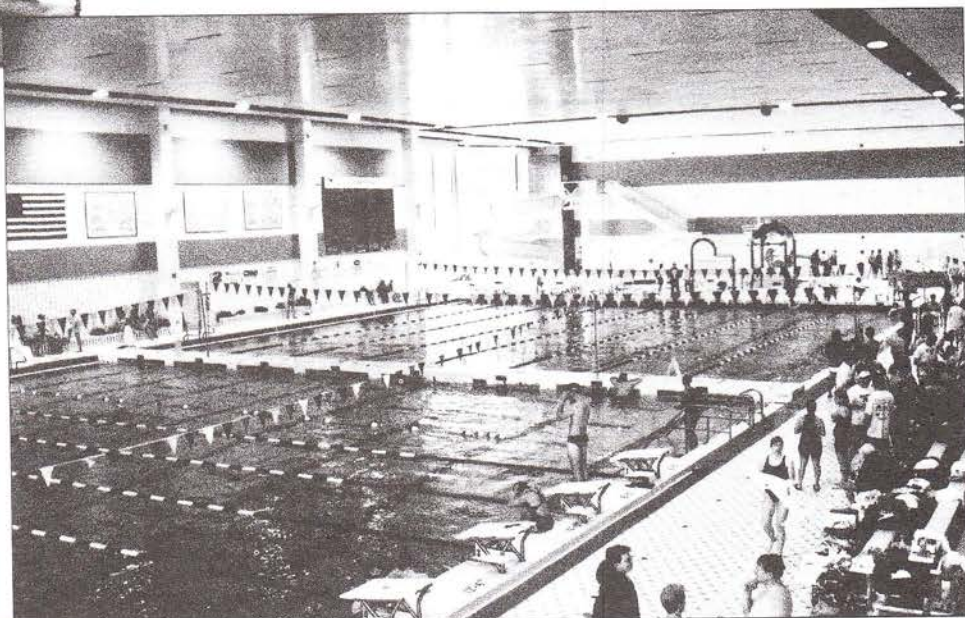

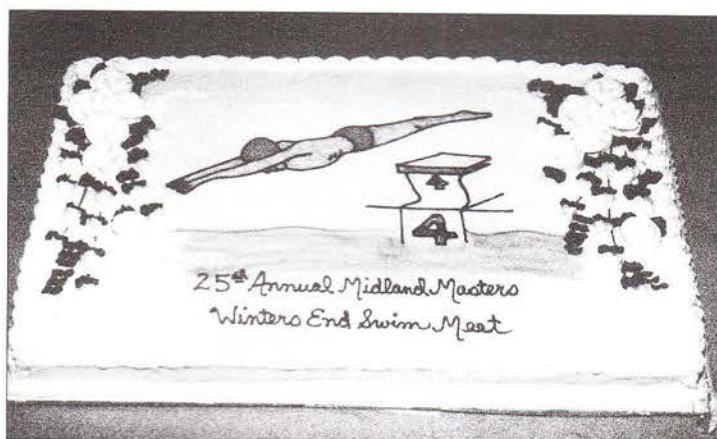


Fred Nelis, recipient of Lynne Award

25th Annual Midland Masters Meet

The Midland Masters Swim Team hosted their 25th annual "Winter's End" swim meet at the H. H. Dow high school pool March 19th. This is the longest continuously scheduled Masters swim meet by any team in Michigan. Michigan Masters president Eric Nordlund and state secretary Skip Thompson presented the entire Midland team with a plaque in appreciation for the many years of effort. Nordlund said, "I hope I'm here for the 50th annual meet."

Meet Director and Midland Masters coach "Weezie" Hofer gave credit to the many volunteers who actually ran

the meet and to the swimmers from Michigan, Ohio and Ontario who came to the meet. "We have a great group of volunteers who helped out at the meet. Some have done it for many of the 25 years of the meet," Weezie said. "We also thank the swimmers who have come to our meet year after year. Without them we wouldn't have a meet. We recognize it's a bit of a drive for many of them to get to Midland so we try to be especially hospitable."

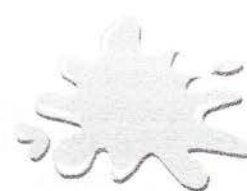
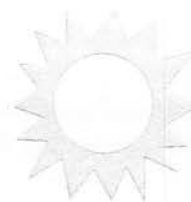
This year the Midland team put up special decorations with colorful 25th Anniversary balloons along the pool deck railing. A 25th Anniversary cake was added to the usual refreshment available to visitors.

Referee and Starter George Newman officiated at the meet. He has officiated all but one of the Winter's End meet -- missing only the year he had hip replacement surgery. Midland Masters swimmer Dick Evans designed T-shirts especially for the meet. These were given out for prizes and also sold at the meet for below cost. Charles Moss, who originated the Winter's End meet in 1976, said, "We've made money on this meet for most of the 25 years so we wanted to give something back to the swimmers. So we did the T-shirts, prizes, cake and decorations."

T-shirts were given for the competitor who came the longest distance, Beverly Meyers from Toledo, Ohio; Bob Heritier who has attended the most Winter's End meets (24) and Edith Glusac who was the oldest swimmer (81) competing. Edith was closely followed by Merlyn Ewbank (81).

Fitness: Summer & Health Reminders

At the Annual Meeting in Holland, Mary Fran Williams, the other "Fitness" co-chair, and I discussed the hope that we could write about "the fitness swimmers" in Michigan. I just received the results of the February Fitness Challenge and saw that Harold Derks of Michigan swam almost 90,000 yards in that month and won his age group, 70-74! Bravo, Harold! I've seen Harold swimming at the YW in Grand Rapids, as well as the GRCC, and we swam a 1650 in a lane together at Rockford. Harold's been involved in Michigan Masters for a long time. Congratulate him when you see him. If you know of some special efforts other Michigan Masters swimmers are making, even though they may not be winning gold medals, please let Mary Mary Fran or I know so that we can tell their stories, too, in the Newsletter.

Summer Fitness and Health Reminders: Get outside and enjoy the natural beauty, but don't forget the sunblock (since we can't wear those big hats in the lake or the pool). Make a concerted effort to eat as many fresh fruits and vegetables as possible, maybe just a little piece of fruit before, and then after practice... just had some great asparagus. Hydrate (drink water) before you get thirsty, especially in warm weather, during work-outs especially. Try different activities: walking (like no golf cart, guys!), cycling (wear a helmet), strength training (get strong, protect those joints)...oh, and

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how about some open water swims, not necessarily in a race (both CATS and SOS plan some lake swims together- one of my swim buddies and I are going to try some Saturday morning swims in a lake up here). De-stress yourself, too, and enjoy those late sunsets or early sunrises. Get some really good rest and sleep, and stretching relieves tension, too.

My friend, Melinda Mann, wrote me that she was missing swimming even though she had just finished going to Nationals. Bob Heritier told me that he really likes to swim 7 days a week. I like 6, myself. I think it's important to rest one day, but even then I miss it. Some others of you may not choose to swim much in the summer, for a break, but it really is the best summer sport of all, so don't stop it completely, even if you only do stroke drills once a week; it'll be easier coming back next fall.

And one last thing, please try to do the mile swim for the June 2-July 4 "Strokes for Stroke" campaign that United States Masters President (and former U of M swimmer) Nancy Ridout has asked us to participate in, in the latest SWIM magazine. It would be really great if a lot of Michigan Masters swimmers would do this. Everybody wins with this program because the entry fee will go to stroke research.

Remember it's not how fast you swim, or how many yards you do, but that you're doing it that's most important! Have a great summer. See you at some of those fun summer meets, or in the big or little lakes. Remember, every day is a gift, especially summer in Michigan.

Year 2000 Short Course Nationals

Forty three Michigan Masters Swimmers (26 men, 17 women) attended the 2000 Short Course Nationals held at the IUPUI Natatorium in Indianapolis, Indiana. 1398 Swimmers were entered in the meet from 151 teams. In total, 116 National and 33 Michigan State Records were set during the course of the four day meet. The Michigan Masters Men's team took 2nd place and the Women's team took 4th place in both Medium Team Division. The Combined Michigan Masters Team placed 4th overall in the Large Team Division.

The high point winner for the Men's Division was Charlie Moss with 56 points. Charlie won the 200 Fly and 400 IM for his first National Championships in 5 years and set 6 State Records in the process. He now has a career total of 55 National Championship Meet Titles and also becomes the leader in Michigan in Individual High Point wins with 14. This is a great comeback for Charlie after going through radiation treatments for an eye tumor, two hip replacements, and major shoulder surgery.

The high point winner for the Women's Division was Lois Nochman with 66 points. Lois won all 6 of her events and set State and National Records in 5 events just missing the 100 IM which she is the current holder of. Lois is the second person in Michigan Masters history to win all 6 of her events (the other being Lynne Weir in 1986) and she now holds all of the National Records in the Fly and IM events for all three courses. I said in the Fall Wave Eater that Lois would set National Records and complete a sweep of the masters courses and she did. Lois now has a streak of 11 straight USMS National Meet Championships. With the end of this meet, Lois has become the Michigan Masters Women's leader with 27 National Championship Meet Titles and 6 Individual High Point Wins. At the meet, Lois received one of the Swimmer of the Year Awards that USMS awards for outstanding swims in the past year. This was presented by Phil Whitten of Swim magazine and an article was written about this in the last issue of Swim magazine.

Edith Glusac, the 1999 Lawrence Award winner almost matched Lois with 5 firsts and 1 second in her individual events setting 2 State Records in the process. This was by far Edith's best USMS National Meet. In 1999, Edith had 5 Number

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1 swims in the USMS Top Ten, and this year she shows no sign of slowing down. With the end of this competition, Edith now has a career 8 USMS National Championship Meet Titles.

Another National Champion to note was Michael Green, a former British Olympian and USMS record holder in the 200 IM. Michael won his first short course National title after taking 2nd 5 times in his last 3 Short Course Nationals. Michael won the 200 IM and set 4 State Records in the other events he swam throughout the meet. He now has a career total of 4 National Championship Meet Titles.

Other swims of note, Bob Heritier won the 1000 Free for his 48th National Championship Meet Title since 1975. The 65+ Free Relay team of Robert Wedell, Bob Heritier, Charlie Moss, and John Ries were Relay National Champions. This is the second time in a row for Charlie, Bob, and John because they won this event at the Long Course Nationals with Freddy Edwards last summer in Minneapolis.

State Records set during the meet by other swimmers for the Women were: Sue Cahill (3), Jennifer Parks (2), and Barb Bos (1). For the Men were: Randy Parker (3), Gaard Arneson (2), and John Ries (1). I would like to congratulate everyone that swam in the meet and helped contribute to the Michigan Masters team effort.

"Strokes For Stroke"

If you have received your June issue of SWIM magazine, you will find a 2 page advertisement for the Strokes For Stroke one mile swim. This is a fundraiser for Stroke awareness sponsored by The National Stroke Foundation, United States Masters Swimming and US Water Polo. The goal is to have 25,000 participants swim one mile or the distance around the world while at the same time raising money and awareness for the treatment and prevention of stroke. The event runs from June 2, 2000 through July 4, 2000.

Now we all know if we are going to have all these people swim a mile, then masters swimmers will have to do the bulk of the work. We on the USMS Fitness Committee are strongly encouraging Coaches and Newsletter Editors to get the word out and induce your swimmers to participate. The following is a letter from USMS President Nancy Ridout regarding Strokes For Stroke.

From the President:

"Strokes for Stroke - as few strokes as possible".

USMS is partnering with the National Stroke Association and USA Water Polo to raise public awareness of the prevention, symptoms, and the treatment of stroke. USMS and USA Water Polo will try to swim around the world, a distance of 25,000 miles, between June 2nd and July 4th to highlight this health risk in the national media.

The goal of the campaign is to raise awareness of stroke. Through our partnership, USMS will benefit by gaining a great deal of national and local exposure and the funds raised will be shared by the National Stroke Association (50%), USMS (25%), and USA Water Polo (25%). If only half of us would swim mile in the "Strokes for Stroke" effort and submit it with the entry fee, we would have contributed 20,000 miles to the goal of swimming around the world and raised \$400,000. That's awesome? Any funds USMS receives will be donated to the USMS Endowment Fund to help fund research in adult health, fitness, training, and competition.

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The campaign will be announced at the Short Course Nationals in Indianapolis, in the May/June issue of SWIM magazine, and in personal contacts to our LMSC Chairs and our coaches from David Grilli and the Fitness Committee who will spearhead this effort for USMS. If you have a story about your own experience as a stroke survivor, or one of a family member or a friend for whom swimming has played a role in the prevention, lessening of effects, or recovery from a stroke, please share it with me. I will forward any of your experiences to the National Stroke Association and post them on the USMS web site. Stroke has affected almost all of us in one way or another. That is why I am excited about the opportunity to support this cause. A healthy lifestyle including exercise and a good diet (both staples of Masters swimming) can prevent or lessen the effects of stroke. Let's take this opportunity to "give back" and support this worthy goal. It's our chance to make a difference

A related memo to Newsletter Editors and USMS membership:

As you know, USMS has embarked on a program to raise money and awareness for the treatment and prevention of stroke. Otherwise known as "Strokes For Stroke," this program involves swimming 1 mile in any measurable venue between Friday, June 2, 2000, through Tuesday, July 4, 2000. The ultimate goal is to have 25,000 participants involved thus swimming a total of 25,000 miles or the distance around the world.

Participation involves a minimum \$25 donation. Of course you can donate more if you like or seek sponsors. There are several incentives for your fund raising efforts based on the amount of money individuals raise. The USMS Fitness Committee would like to add more incentive by acknowledging 3 different categories of participation.

At the annual Convention we will award the group or club that raises the most money, has the most swimmers participate and the highest percentage of participation amongst their group. Coaches and club organizers should contact me at mushield@aol.com to register for the group participation awards.
