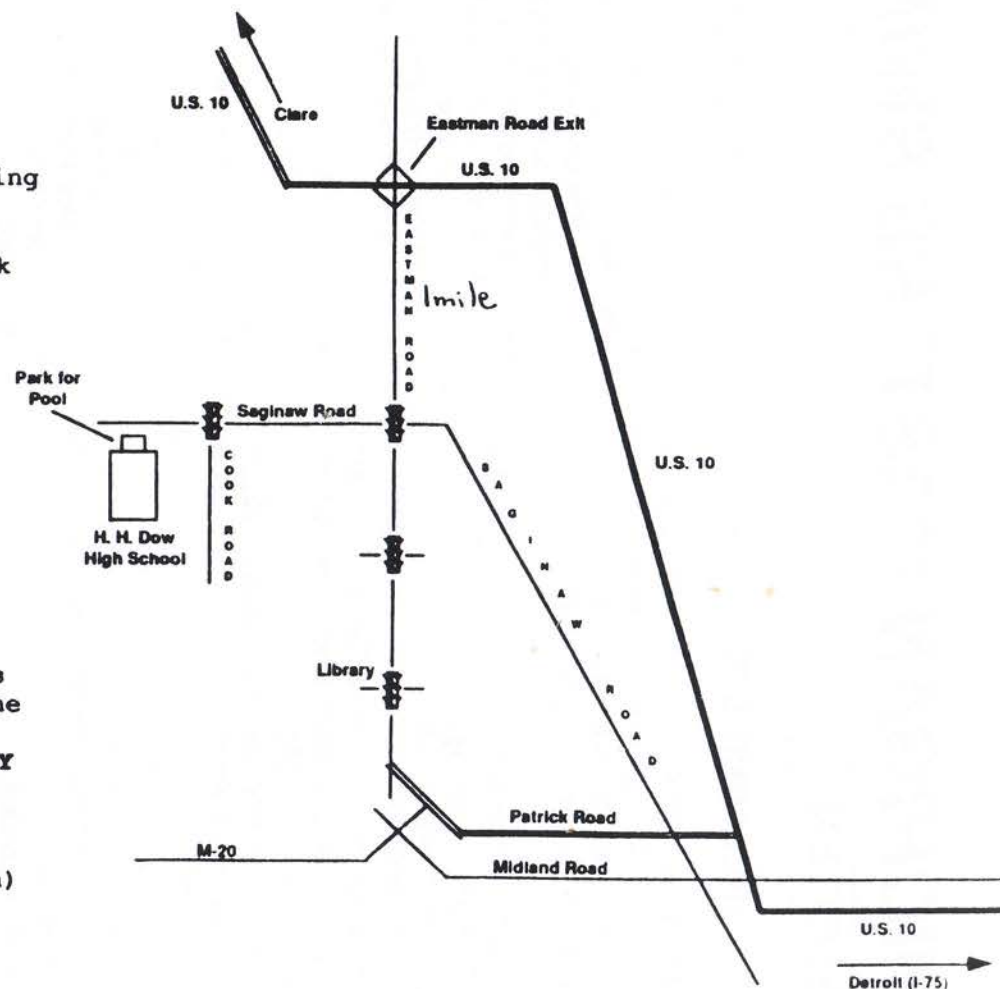

**ARTICLE IX.
DUES AND FEES**

9.1 **ATHLETE REGISTRATION** - Each member, or swimming organization on his or her behalf, shall pay to the Registration Chairman an annual fee established by the MMSA, which fee shall include a charge for insurance and the national USMS fee.

**ARTICLE X.
HEARINGS, APPEALS AND ATHLETE'S RIGHTS**

10.1 **ATHLETE'S BILL OF RIGHTS** - The MMSA, in accordance with the rules of the USMS, shall respect and protect the right of every eligible individual to participate in any recognized capacity in any masters swimming competition, so long as such competition is conducted in compliance with reasonable local, national and applicable requirements.

10.2 **REVIEW SECTION** - The General Assembly shall annually elect a Review Section comprised of no less than five (5) members. Its hearings may be conducted by an attorney at law retained by the Review Section for that purpose. If the attorney is not a member of the USMS, he shall have no vote. The Chairman of the Review Section shall be elected by its membership. A quorum for any hearing conducted by the Review Section shall be fifty (50) percent of its membership, but no less than three (3).

10.4 **APPEAL** - The decision of the Review Section will be final in all cases, subject only to appeal to the General Assembly of the MMSA at the option of the applicant, and thereafter to the USMS National Board of Review.

10.5 **NOTICE TO ATHLETES** - In each case, where notice is mailed to a registered athlete, it is sufficient to mail the notice addressed to him at the residence given in his application for registration; or if a written change of address has been submitted, then to such address.

**ARTICLE XI.
MISCELLANEOUS**

11.1 **FISCAL YEAR** - The fiscal year of the MMSA shall run from September 1 to August 31 annually.

11.2 **MAILING ADDRESS** - The MMSA will submit a permanent mailing address for use by the national headquarters.

11.3 **DISSOLUTION** - Upon Dissolution, the net assets of the MMSA will not inure to the benefit of any private individual or corporation, but will be distributed to United States Masters Swimming, Inc. to be used exclusively for educational or charitable purposes, or if United States Master Swimming Inc. is not in existence, or is not then a corporation which is exempt under Section 501(C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and to which contributions, bequests and gifts are deductible under Sections 170 (C) (2), 2055 (A) (2) and 2522 (A) (2) thereof, such assets shall be distributed to such a corporation, to be used exclusively for educational or charitable purposes.

BY-LAWS OF THE MICHIGAN MASTERS SWIMMING ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I.

1.1 OBJECTIVES - The objectives shall be to promote and develop swimming for the benefit of all abilities, in accordance with the standards and under the rules prescribed by the United States Masters Swimming, Inc., hereinafter called USMS, and the Michigan Masters Swimming Association, hereinafter called MMSA.

1.2 BOUNDARIES - The geographic boundaries of MMSA shall be the State of Michigan.

1.3 JURISDICTION - The MMSA shall have jurisdiction over the sport of masters swimming as has been delegated to it by USMS.

ARTICLE II. MEMBERSHIP

2.1 The membership shall consist of the following:

1. Group Members - Those swim organizations which have joined and are in good standing with the MMSA, and who have athletes registered to represent said organization in masters swimming. Each group member shall appoint a representative to the General Assembly of the MMSA. Such appointment will be made by the Chief Executive Officer of the group and may be changed by him at any time.

2. Individual Members (unattached) - Each individual who is interested in the purposes or programs of the MMSA, and who has registered with same.

2.2 Every member will receive a USMS card certifying his or her membership and may attend all meetings of the MMSA.

2.3 RESPONSIBILITIES

I. Duties and Powers

- (a) To elect officers through their representatives;
- (b) To ratify or rescind policy and programs established by the Michigan Masters Swimming Committee, hereinafter called MMSC;
- (c) To amend the By Laws of the MMSA.

ARTICLE III. MANAGEMENT

3.1 MMSA GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

1. Members - The MMSA General Assembly shall consist of:

- (a) Each officer of the MMSC; and
- (b) A representative of each recognized organization in good standing, plus a member-at-large appointed from the list of unattached swimmers. This member-at-large shall be appointed by the President of the MMSC, with approval by other elected officers.

2. Each representative and each officer is entitled to one (1) vote. Proxy voting is not permitted.

3. Duties and Powers -

(a) The General Assembly of the MMSA shall hold an Annual Meeting concurrent with the Michigan State Swimming Championships to consider any business relating to masters swimming in Michigan. Special Meetings of the General Assembly may be called by the MMSC or by petition of one-third (1/3) of the representatives to the General Assembly. All meetings are open to all registered swimmers;

(b) The General Assembly elects officers;

(c) The General Assembly may override any action of the MMSC by simple majority vote;

(d) The President of the MMSC presides at all General Assembly meetings, but may vote only to break a tie; and

(e) Reviews and adopts the annual budget of the MMSA.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

4.1 NUMBER OF OFFICERS

1. The elected officers are President, President-elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Registration, and Sanctions Chairman.

2. The appointed officers are Records Chairman and Newsletter Editor. Appointees are named by the President, subject to approval by other elected officers.

4.2 ELIGIBILITY - Any Michigan swimmer holding a current USMS registration card is eligible to hold office.

4.3 TERM OF OFFICE - Each elected officer shall serve for a term of two (2) years commencing on October 1. Each appointed officer shall serve for a term of one (1) year. The President-elect ascends to the office of President automatically at the end of his term.

4.4 NOMINATION - The President will select a nominations subcommittee consisting of three (3) members to submit a slate of names for elected offices. This subcommittee will be formed two (2) months prior to elections. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at election time.

4.5 VACANCIES - Vacancies created for any reason in any office may be filled by appointment of the President, subject to approval of the MMSC. Such appointees will serve until the next regularly scheduled Annual Meeting. In the event of a vacancy in the office of President, the President-elect will fill that position until the next Annual Meeting.

4.6 DUTIES

1. President - President shall be responsible for the day to day management of the business affairs of the MMSA. He shall call meetings when deemed necessary and preside at such meetings. He shall, with approval of the MMSC, appoint committees as necessary to fulfill the responsibilities of the MMSA.

2. President-Elect - President-elect serves as a replacement for the President whenever he is absent or unable to perform his duties. He assists the President whenever required. He chairs an awards committee to give annual recognition to deserving registered swimmers.

3. Secretary - Secretary is responsible for keeping a record of all meetings, preparing official correspondence, keeps Minutes of meetings and makes reports as may be required by the MMSA and/or USMS.

4. Treasurer - Treasurer shall receive all monies and pay all bills approved by the MMSC or authorized separately by the General Assembly. He shall maintain all financial records and make timely reports as requested by the MMSC. He shall chair a committee of the MMSC to formulate and present an annual budget to the General Assembly.

5. Registration and Sanctions Chairman - Registration and Sanctions Chairman shall be responsible for the registration of swimmers and maintain an up to date list of all registrants. He will assist meet managers in acquiring meet sanctions.

6. Records Chairman - Records Chairman shall maintain timely swimming records of Michigan swimmers for events recognized by the USMS. He will publish these records as may be required and post the requirements before a record can be recognized.

7. Newsletter Editor - Newsletter Editor is responsible for all editorial and publishing duties of the Michigan Swim-Master. Publication dates will be determined by the MMSC.

ARTICLE V. MEETINGS

5.1 ANNUAL MEETING - The Annual Meeting of the General Assembly will be held concurrently with the Michigan State Swimming Championships in April.

5.2 SPECIAL MEETING - A Special Meeting may be called at the discretion of the President of the MMSC or by petition of one-third (1/3) of the membership of the General Assembly.

5.3 NOTICES - Notice of any Special Meeting of the General Assembly shall be promulgated by the Secretary no fewer than ten (10) days prior to such meeting. This Notice will contain time, date, site and purpose of said meeting.

5.4 QUORUM - A quorum of fifty (50) percent must be present to conduct business at any meeting of the General Assembly or the MMSC.

5.5 RULES OF ORDER - The current Robert's Rules of Order are the procedural rules.

ARTICLE VI. BY-LAW AMENDMENTS

6.1 APPROVAL AND AMENDMENTS

1. All By-Laws and amendments will be approved by a majority vote of the responding registered swimmers in Michigan on a written ballot.

2. Proposed changes to the By-Laws will be published at least thirty (30) days prior to a written vote on such amendments. Notice in the Michigan Swim-Master and/or at a regularly scheduled swim meet constitutes adequate publicity of amendments.

3. Proposed amendments to the By-Laws may be submitted at any time by any representative to the General Assembly.

ARTICLE VII. CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

7.1 GENERAL - The conditions of competition in any swimming event, and the rules governing it, shall be those established by the USMS or the MMSA where its rules and regulations do not contradict the rules of USMS.

ARTICLE VIII. CHAMPIONSHIPS

8.1 Swimming championships, when conducted, will be held in accordance with the rules of the USMS for conduct of championships.

This meet will be held at the Don Canham Natatorium at the University of Michigan. The natatorium is located at the corner of Hoover and State Streets in Ann Arbor, Michigan (see map).

FACILITIES:

The Don Canham Natatorium will be configured as two 25 yard, eight lane courses. The West course will be used for competition and the east course will be available for continuous warm-up/warm-down (except for the distance events on Friday). **The diving pool and the area between the bulkheads is off-limits at all times.** All events (except for some events on Friday Night) will be timed using an eight-lane Colorado Timing System. Swimmer's name and times will be displayed on a scoreboard. Timers operating the manual back-up buttons and a manual back-up stop watch will be supplied for all lanes. Swimmers in the east course on Friday Night will be timed by one watch.

WARM-UP AND COMPETITION TIMES:

ELIGIBILITY:

Any swimmer registered in USMS may swim in this meet. "Applied for" may be entered in place of a USMS number only if a USMS registration application is enclosed with the entry form along with the \$25.00 USMS and Michigan LMSC registration fee. If an unverifiable USMS number is submitted with an entry, the swimmer will be forced to buy a USMS card at check-in. Swimmers from other LMSC's may compete in relays only if all four swimmers in the relay are from the same club. No unattached relays may be entered. Only swimmers registered in the Michigan LMSC can establish state records. In order for a swimmer to score points for a swim club, that individual must enter by mail, postmarked by the entry deadline of March 22. All swimmers entering after the entry deadline or deck-entering must swim unattached. In addition all late and deck entries will be assessed a deck entry fee of \$10.00.

The 1000 freestyle, the 500 freestyle and the 400 IM can be swum either on Friday Night (April 2) or during the weekend sessions but not both. If the swimmer desires to swim events on Friday Night, the seed time(s) for the event(s) should be placed on the top lines of the entry form corresponding to the Friday Night events. If the swimmer desires to swim the events during the weekend sessions, the seed time(s) should be placed in the event listed in the Saturday or Sunday session. The 1650 freestyle will only be swum on Friday Night.

All events on Friday night will be swum in the first seven lanes of both courses. The west course will be provided with electronic timing and one timer per lane operating the back-up pushbutton. The east course will be supplied with one timer per lane operating a watch. If a swimmer on the east course wishes his performance to be considered for a record or a top-10 placing, he must supply two other timers with watches. All swimmers in the 500 yard freestyle, 1000 yard freestyle and the 1650 yard freestyle must supply their own counters.

ENTRY PROCEDURE - INDIVIDUAL EVENTS:

To enter individual events, swimmers should select their events (maximum of seven), and enter a seed time (in short course yards) in the "entry time" box on the entry form. All swimmers entering with no seed time will swim in the slowest heats. All swimmers who enter more than seven events will be entered in the first seven events of the entry form. The meet director's decisions will be final in this matter. The available age groups are 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, etc.

ENTRY PROCEDURE - RELAYS:

To enter relays, swimmers should enter the number of relays entries in the "entry time" box of the relay event on the entry form. It is requested that only one entry from with relay entries be submitted for each club. At the beginning of warm-up for each weekend session, relay cards for that session will be available. A team representative should pick up the cards for their club and supply the following data:

1. Names (first and last), ages and sex of all swimmers.
2. Age group in which the relay is to be entered. Relays in Michigan are "sum of the ages". Available age groups are 76+, 100+, 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+, etc.
3. Name of lead-off swimmer.
4. Seed time for the relay.

The completed relay cards shall be return to the clerk of the course within one (1) hour after the start of competition for the session. Cards received after the one hour time limit are subject to being scratched. The meet director's decisions will be final in this matter. After receipt of all cards, the heats will be seeded by time and the cards made available to the teams. All relays will be seeded slow-to-fast with men and women swimming together. A swimmer may swim on one relay per event for a total of four relays in the meet.

ENTRY PROCEDURE - DECK ENTERED INDIVIDUAL EVENTS & RELAYS:

Swimmers are reminded to enter the pools (during pre-meet and continuous warm-ups) feet first in a cautious manner with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck or gutter during all warm-ups and warm-downs (THIS IS A NEW USMS RULE). 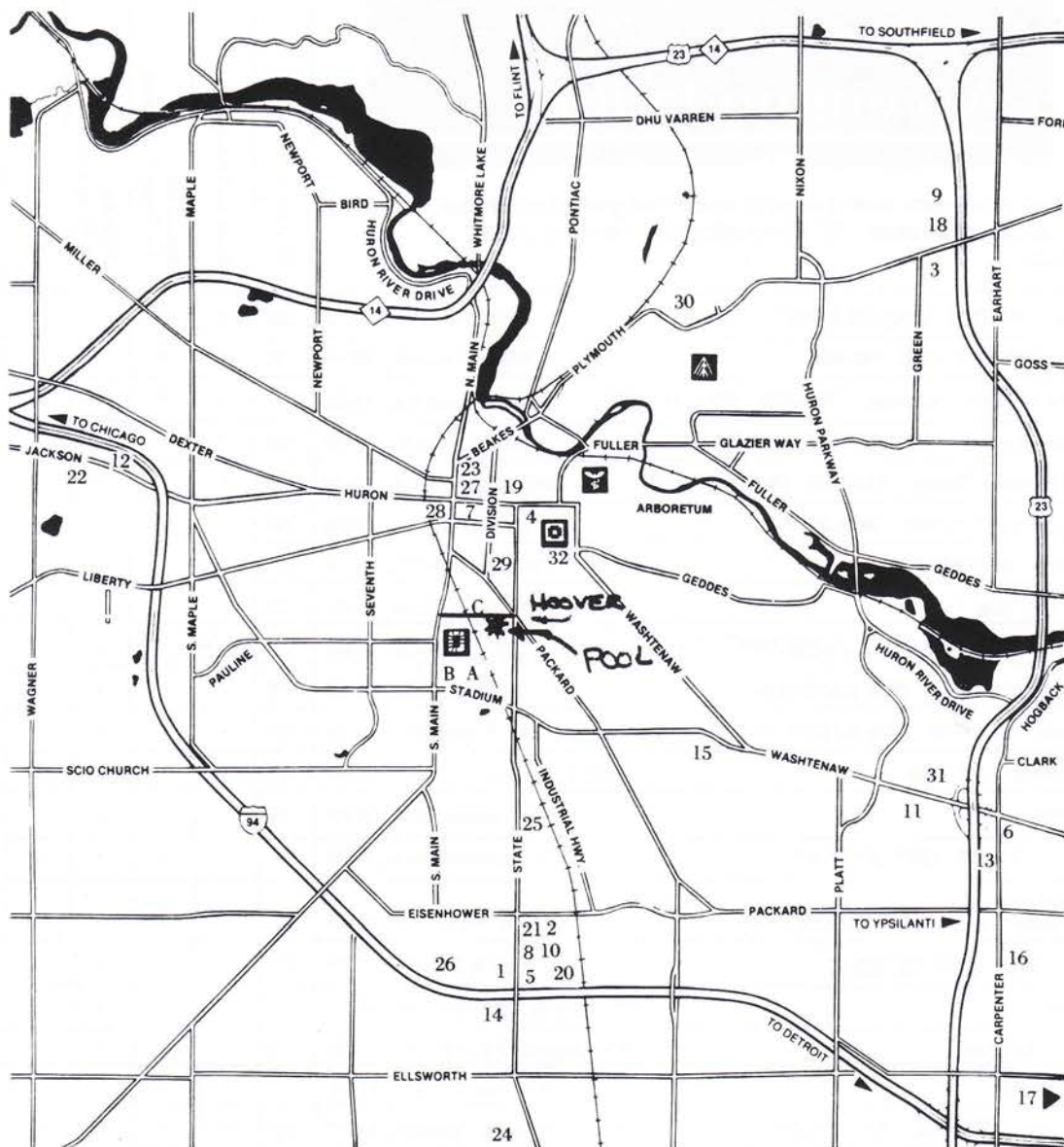

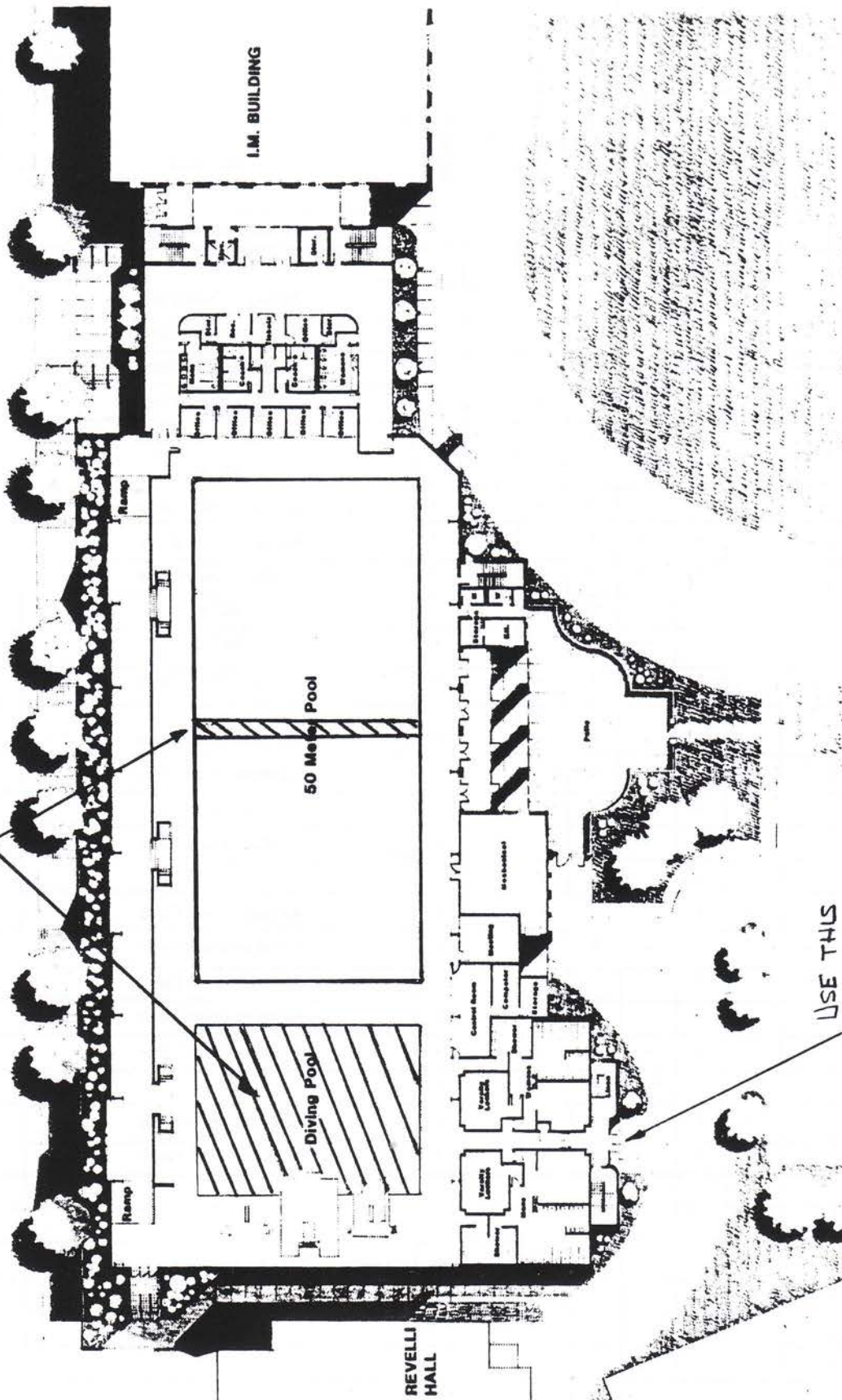
