

Captain Report for 2025

Canadian Nationals Windsor

On Memorial Day weekend 2024, 53 Michigan Masters swimmers crossed the border to swim at the Canadian Nationals. Last time Michigan Masters attended this was in 2014. The team broke 47 individual State records and 13 relay records. In addition, Corrin Buck broke 2 USMS National records in the 50 and 100 breaststroke. Denise Brown was 7 for 7 national champion and 6 for 7 state records making her our TOP Michigan Masters Athlete!!! As a team, we won 70 Gold medals, 53 silver and 47 Bronze. If we were allowed to score, Michigan Masters would have been National Champs.

USMS Spring Nationals in Indianapolis

In June 2024, 99 Michigan Masters swimmers headed to Indianapolis to swim at IUPUI natatorium along with many attending the Olympic trials. The Michigan Masters team placed 3rd in the regional division in the combined, men and women categories. High point winner for our Michigan Masters team for women, Corrin Buck with 57 points and for men, Jens Kristensen with 47 points.
